

GLOSSARY OF BINDER TERMS

Russia— 100% Real leather binding material. 3/4 Fab— A binder with imitation leather covers & leather backbone, (usually red). Indestructo— Is a name for high impact poly styrene mate ial used in making binders.

Fly sheets, endsheets— These protective sheets are the very first & last sheets and are standard in almost every binder.

Endtins— These are protective metal edges attached to the binding side of end sheets.

Stud Posts— These are 1/8" diameter posts attached to endsheets (usually 2 posts on front endsheet & 2 posts on the back endsheet). They are used to help guide the paper filler back onto the binding posts after having been removed from binder.

Bounce back or Rubber back— A rubber padded backbone found on some curved back binders. The idea is to absorb shock if dropped.

Post— This metal rod (either round or rectangle), is what holds the sheets into the binder. **Pulls**— Are sliding bars which release & lock the post in position of a recorder binder.

Binding Side or B.S.— The side of the sheet that is punched for binding.

Covered— Wrapped with some type of binding material.

Line of Lettering— This actually refers to each impression needed for imprinting of the lettering copy. A line can be one or more words, up to 9" in length.

Finishing or Tooling— Gold or ink decorative lines added to backbone or covers.

Ruled & Printed — This refers to binder filler sheets or forms that have special colored lines & printed headings.

Sheets & Pages— A sheet is a single piece of paper. There are 2 pages to every sheet, (1 on each side of the sheet).

Spec. A Binder— Is to determine all necessary specifications needed for ordering or price quotations.
